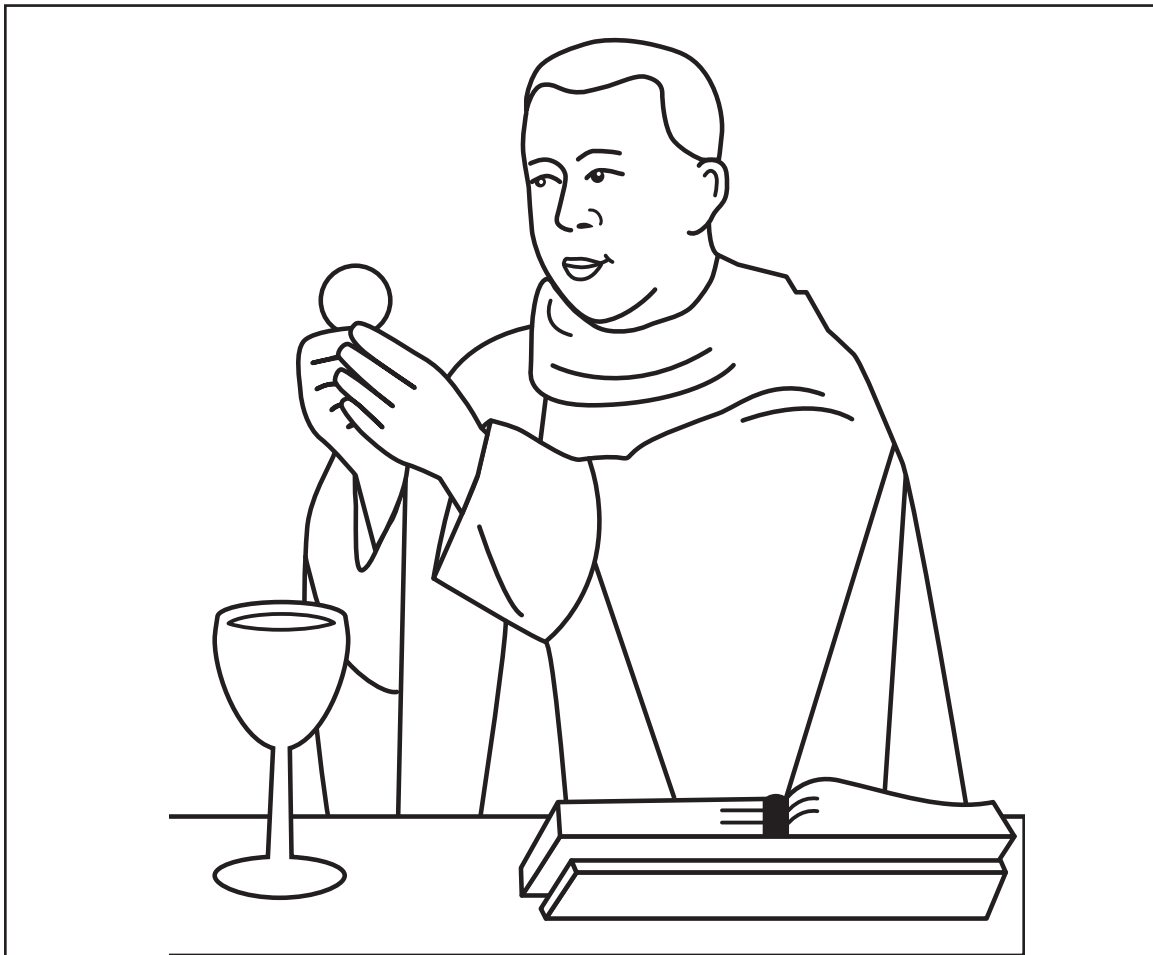


This Is My Body, This Is My Blood

During the consecration at Mass, the priest repeats the words of Jesus at the Last Supper. The bread and wine become the Body and Blood of Christ. This is called *transubstantiation*. Then the priest invites everyone to pray the Lord's Prayer and to share a sign of peace.
