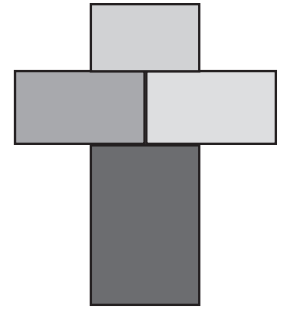

Liturgical Colors

In the Church different colors have different symbolic meanings. White represents purity and joy. Red symbolizes fire, the Holy Spirit, and the Jesus' Passion. Green, which reminds us of plants and trees, is a symbol of life and hope. Purple is a symbol of penitence.

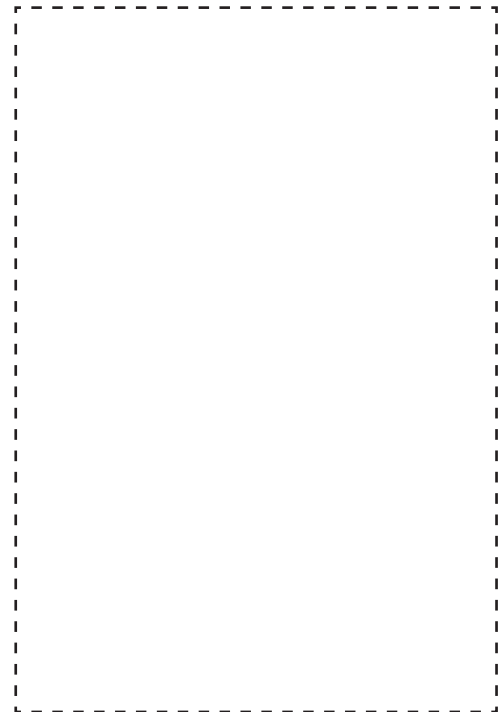
