1. _____ Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain are retained. *John 20:23*

2. _____ Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the holy Spirit. *Matthew 28:19*

3. _____ Is anyone among you sick? He should summon the presbyters of the church, and they should pray over him and anoint [him] with oil in the name of the Lord . . . *James 5:14*

4. _____ Jesus said to them, "I am the bread of life; whoever comes to me will never hunger, and whoever believes in me will never thirst." *John 6:35*

5. _____ So they are no longer two but one flesh. Therefore, what God has joined together, no human being must separate. *Matthew 19:6*

6. _____ They appointed presbyters for them in each church and, with prayer and fasting, commended them to the Lord in whom they had put their faith. *Acts of the Apostles 14:23*

7. _____ Then they laid hands on them and they received the holy Spirit. *Acts of the Apostles 8:17*
