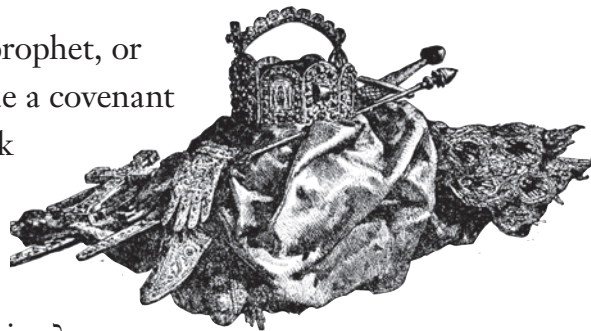


Priests, Prophets, and Kings
