# To Dobra Nowina Jezusa zmienia świat i serca.

"«Nawracajcie się, albowiem bliskie jest królestwo niebieskie» – to wezwanie jest jak potężny promień światła, przenikający ciemności i przecinający obłoki". Chrystus pierwsze kroki podczas swojego nauczania skierował na obrzeża, w miejsca przenikania się ludów i kultur.

Wraz z przyjściem Jezusa, będącego światłością świata, Bóg Ojciec okazał ludzkości swoją bliskość i przyjaźń, całkowicie za darmo i bezinteresownie. To w tej perspektywie możliwe jest nawrócenie. Najpierw jest inicjatywa Boga, potem przychodzi odpowiedź człowieka.





#### Dear Parishioners


